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Collection of your Personal Information

Habitat For Humanity Greater Birmingham collects personally identifiable information, such as your email address, name, home or work address or telephone number. Habitat For Humanity Greater Birmingham also collects anonymous demographic information, which is not unique to you, such as your ZIP code, age, gender, preferences, interests and favorites.

There is also information about your computer hardware and software that is automatically collected by Habitat For Humanity Greater Birmingham. This information can include: your IP address, browser type, domain names, access times and referring website addresses. This information is used by Habitat For Humanity Greater Birmingham for the operation of the service, to maintain quality of the service, and to provide general statistics regarding use of the Habitat For Humanity Greater Birmingham site.

Please keep in mind that if you directly disclose personally identifiable information or personally sensitive data through Habitat For Humanity Greater Birmingham public message boards, this information may be collected and used by others. Note: Habitat For Humanity Greater Birmingham does not read any of your private online communications.

Use of your Personal Information

Habitat For Humanity Greater Birmingham collects and uses your personal information to operate the Habitat For Humanity Greater Birmingham Web site and deliver the services you have requested. Habitat For Humanity Greater Birmingham also uses your personally identifiable information to inform you of other products or services available from Habitat For Humanity Greater Birmingham and its affiliates. Habitat For Humanity Greater Birmingham may also contact you via surveys to conduct research about your opinion of current services or of potential new services that may be offered.

Habitat For Humanity Greater Birmingham does not sell, rent or lease its customer lists to third parties. Habitat For Humanity Greater Birmingham may, from time to time, contact you on behalf of external business partners about a particular offering that may be of interest to you. In those cases,

your unique personally identifiable information (e-mail, name, address, telephone number) is not transferred to the third party. In addition, Habitat For Humanity Greater Birmingham may share data with trusted partners to help us perform statistical analysis, send you email or postal mail, provide customer support, or arrange for deliveries. All such third parties are prohibited from using your personal information except to provide these services to Habitat For Humanity Greater Birmingham, and they are required to maintain the confidentiality of your information.

Habitat For Humanity Greater Birmingham does not use or disclose sensitive personal information, such as race, religion, or political affiliations, without your explicit consent.

Habitat For Humanity Greater Birmingham keeps track of the Web sites and pages our customers visit within Habitat For Humanity Greater Birmingham, in order to determine what Habitat For Humanity Greater Birmingham services are the most popular. This data is used to deliver customized content and advertising within Habitat For Humanity Greater Birmingham to customers whose behavior indicates that they are interested in a particular subject area.

Use of Cookies

The Habitat For Humanity Greater Birmingham Web site use "cookies" to help you personalize your online experience. A cookie is a text file that is placed on your hard disk by a Web page server. Cookies cannot be used to run programs or deliver viruses to your computer. Cookies are uniquely assigned to you, and can only be read by a web server in the domain that issued the cookie to you.

One of the primary purposes of cookies is to provide a convenience feature to save you time. The purpose of a cookie is to tell the Web server that you have returned to a specific page. Security of your Personal Information

When personal information (such as a credit card number) is transmitted to other Web sites, it is protected through the use of encryption, such as the Secure Socket Layer (SSL) protocol.
